Office of the Vice President of Student Affairs

University Housing for reasons of health, normal maintenance, upholding community standards, fire and safety, and other necessary repairs to rooming units in cases of health and safety, fire, misfilings, or rooming unit maintenance. A search of a rooming unit will be made only with: (1) his or her consent; or (2) a University Search Authorization issued by the Vice President of Student Affairs or designee; or (3) a warrant from a judge, court, or lawfully authorized search.

give rise to a belief that a search will

be conducted that is not in the best interests of the community. A search of a rooming unit will be conducted if the Vice President of Student Affairs or designee believes that a search is necessary to protect the health and safety of the occupants of the rooming unit or to protect the Boston College community. A University Search Authorization will set forth the premises, the person or persons to be searched, and the date, time, and place of the search. The search will remain valid within which the warrant will remain valid.

A search based upon a University Search Authorization will be conducted by the Boston College Police Department or the Director of Residential Life or their designees and other university officials deemed appropriate in the situation.
